

# Montgomery County Community Foundation Lilly Endowment Community Scholarship 2010 Application

## About the Lilly Endowment Community Scholarship Program

The program will provide scholarships for full tuition, required fees, and a special allocation of up to \$800 per year for required books and required equipment for four years of undergraduate study on a full-time basis leading to a baccalaureate degree at any Indiana public or private college or university accredited by the Higher Learning Commission of the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools.

To be considered for the Lilly Endowment Community Scholarship, you must meet the following requirements:

1. You must graduate by the end of June 2010 with a diploma from an accredited Montgomery County high school; and have been accepted to pursue a baccalaureate course of study, on a full time basis, at an accredited public or private college or university in Indiana.
2. You must be ranked in the top 1/3 of your graduating class.
3. You must currently be a resident of Montgomery County, Indiana and have lived in Montgomery County, Indiana since August 2008.
4. You are not eligible to apply for the Lilly Endowment Community Scholarship if you are the child, grandchild, great grandchild, spouse, brother, sister, brother-in-law or sister-in-law of a person who during the last three years has served as a member of the Board of Directors, Scholarship Committee or Staff of the Montgomery County Community Foundation.
5. You are not eligible to apply for the Lilly Endowment Community Scholarship if you are currently participating in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Scholar program.

The application process is designed for us to learn as much about you as possible. This is your opportunity to showcase your abilities and your experiences. Selection of scholarship finalists is based 60% on academic achievement and the essay and 40% on activities, leadership and the interview. If you are selected as a semi-finalist, you will be required to appear before the Board of Directors for an interview. Independent Colleges of Indiana will make the final scholarship selection and may award up to two scholarships to Montgomery County students.

## Personal Statement

The personal statement will allow us to become acquainted with you in ways different from courses, grades, test scores, and other objective data. It will allow us to get to know you better as an individual. Through writing, the personal statement will demonstrate your ability to organize thoughts and express yourself. Your personal statement should be between 300 - 500 typed words and should address the following statement: ***Imagine you have been given a fellowship allowing you to defer your college entrance for a year to pursue a project that is of great interest to you. Describe what you would do with your year and the project you would pursue.***

Checklist for Applicants:

- Completed application (signature required)**
- Official high school transcript – must include 7 semesters**
- SAT scores - accepted from official high school transcript or directly from SAT testing service**
- Personal Statement (must be on 8 1/2 x 11 standard white paper, no font smaller than a 10, do not include your name on the personal statement page)**

**Confidentiality Statement:** All personal information (i.e. name, sex, address, high school) will be blacked out. Your identity will remain anonymous to the selection committee unless you are selected to interview with the MCCF Board of Directors for the Lilly Endowment Community Scholarship. **Please do not use identifying information except where specifically requested.**

*“I will keep the Montgomery County Community Foundation apprised at the end of each term (semester or quarter) of my academic status by submitting an official grade report (1<sup>st</sup> term) and an official transcript (2<sup>nd</sup> term) within 14 days of receiving it.”*

*“I will keep the Montgomery County Community Foundation apprised annually by June 1<sup>st</sup> of my enrollment and academic status during college, by completing and returning any surveys or forms as may be provided by the community foundation.”*

*“If selected, I will notify the Montgomery County Community Foundation no later than April 28, 2010, which college or university I will attend.”*

*“Upon graduation, I will keep the Montgomery County Community Foundation apprised annually by June 1<sup>st</sup> of my education and /or employment status for at least ten years after graduation, by completing and returning an alumni survey or other forms as may be provided by the community foundation.*

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## ***Application Instructions***

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**Please read and follow all instructions carefully. Failure to follow instructions may eliminate your application from consideration.**

- You must fill out your own application and write the personal statement or essay in your own words. It is acceptable to ask for proofreading and other help but *all work must be yours*.
- Include all requested materials (and only the requested materials) and fill out the application completely and accurately. Incomplete or unsigned applications will not be considered.
- Use the application form and the space provided *only*. Do not include attachments except as requested. (for example the personal statement)
- All pages of the application should be single-sided only. Do not use the back of pages to submit information; it will not be considered as part of your application unless our office has instructed you to put information on the back of a page.
- Please do not tape, staple, glue, or otherwise fasten any part of or anything to your application.
- The completed application should be submitted in a large envelope. Do not fold application.
- All materials, including references, transcripts, etc. must be received by the deadline or the application will not be considered. If written references are requested as a part of the application, it is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that the references have been received.
- Please do not use identifying information except where specifically requested. Your identity will remain anonymous to the selection committee.
- Use the check list found on the cover page to be certain all items have been included in your scholarship application before turning it in to the committee.
- Do not use pencil to complete your application; print in ink or type.
- Please keep a copy of the application. We cannot provide copies of any application materials, including transcripts, financial information, and references, once submitted.
